3. any machine or mechanical device that operates automatically with humanlike skill.

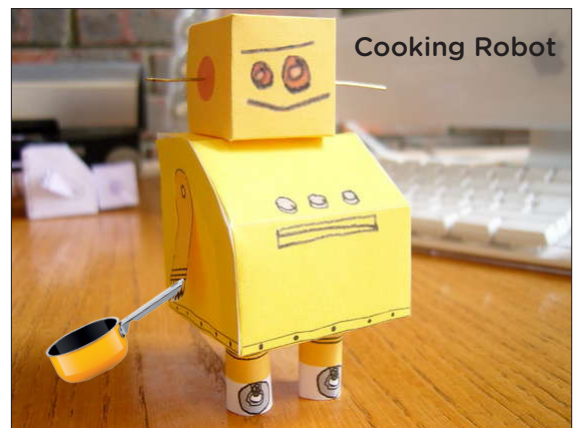
Acrostic Poem
